Food Check-Out Week is a national campaign led by the American Farm Bureau which commemorates America's healthy, nutritious, abundant and affordable food supply. According to the United States Department of Agriculture, on average, American consumers spend approximately 10% of their disposable income for food. When applied to the calendar, that comes out to around 40 days. That's a positive message especially when you consider the average American has to work until early May before they earn enough to pay their taxes. With a focus on affordable food in the United States, this campaign provides an excellent opportunity for county Farm Bureaus to show the value of local farmers.
