



2018 Lawrence County Farm Bureau Scholarship Application

Lawrence County Farm Bureau will award three \$2,000 scholarships for the current school year. One thousand dollars during the Fall 2018 Semester and one thousand dollars during the Spring 2018 Semester to the winning applicants.

Payments will be made to the school upon proof of enrollment.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- Be the child or grandchild of a Lawrence County Farm Bureau Member Family. Family must have been a member during the previous year, 2017, a current member in 2018, and remain such while the scholarship is in force.
- Students must be a current senior and finish high school within the year they apply for the scholarship.
- Priority will be given to students with an interest in pursuing a career in agriculture.
- No child or grandchild of Farm Bureau Board or Farm Bureau Employees will be eligible.

Rules

- Recipient must attend either a college/university or a vocational/technical institute.
- Recipient must enter the college/university or vocational/technical institute no later than the fall semester once the scholarship has been awarded.
- Applications must be mailed to no later than May 8, 2018. Completed applications should be mailed to:

- Applicants will be judged by an appointed committee. All decisions are final.
- The awards committee will make the final determination on all cases concerning the interpretation of these rules. Applications will not be returned.
- Once school enrollment has been provided to Lawrence County Farm Bureau scholarship payment will be awarded.
