

Kentucky Farm Bureau Education Foundation 2018 Current College Student Scholarship Program

Scholarships available to current college students for the 2018-2019 school year.

Eligibility and Guidelines

- To be eligible for the county scholarships listed below, the applicant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be a member of the county Farm Bureau sponsoring the scholarship and remain such, while the scholarship is in force.
- The following individuals and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply: Kentucky Farm Bureau Agency Managers, Agents, County Secretaries and CSRs, District and State Farm Bureau Employees, members of the Kentucky Farm Bureau Board of Directors, State Young Farmer and Women's Advisory Committees.
- Dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, shall cause the recipient to lose the scholarship. The remaining award will then go to the first alternate.
- Recipient must be a full-time student each semester unless an exception is requested in writing and approved. Winner is required to annually furnish a transcript before additional monies are sent to their college.
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 after each semester or forfeit the award.
- The awards committee will make the final determination on all cases concerning the interpretation of these rules. All applications become the property of the Kentucky Farm Bureau Education Foundation and will not be returned.

COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2018

Oldham County Farm Bureau Current College Student Scholarship

A scholarship of \$2,000 will be awarded annually to a student who is currently enrolled in a college/university or technical school. The recipient must be a member of Oldham County Farm Bureau at least one year prior to applying for this scholarship. If the student majors in agriculture, the scholarship increases to \$3,000.

Shelby County Farm Bureau Current College Student Scholarship

A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded annually to a student who is currently enrolled in a college/university. The recipient must be a member of Shelby County Farm Bureau.

Application Deadline

Application must be postmarked by April 27, 2018. The selected recipients will be notified by a county Farm Bureau representative on or before May 18, 2018.
