### **ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES AND YOUTH**

ATV's are fun and exciting especially for kids and teenagers. However they can also be dangerous if proper precautions are not taken by riders.

The Federal Government offers six safety tips for all riders to follow. These are:

1. Take safety training courses. Learn how to ride and handle various situations.
2. Wear protective gear such as helmet, long pants, long sleeved shirts, goggles and boots to help protect your body.
3. Never ride with a passenger
4. Children should never ride adult ATV's. They are more difficult to handle than youth ATV's.
5. Never take your ATV on paved roads. They are made for off road use and are harder to handle on paved roads.
6. Do not drive under the influence.
